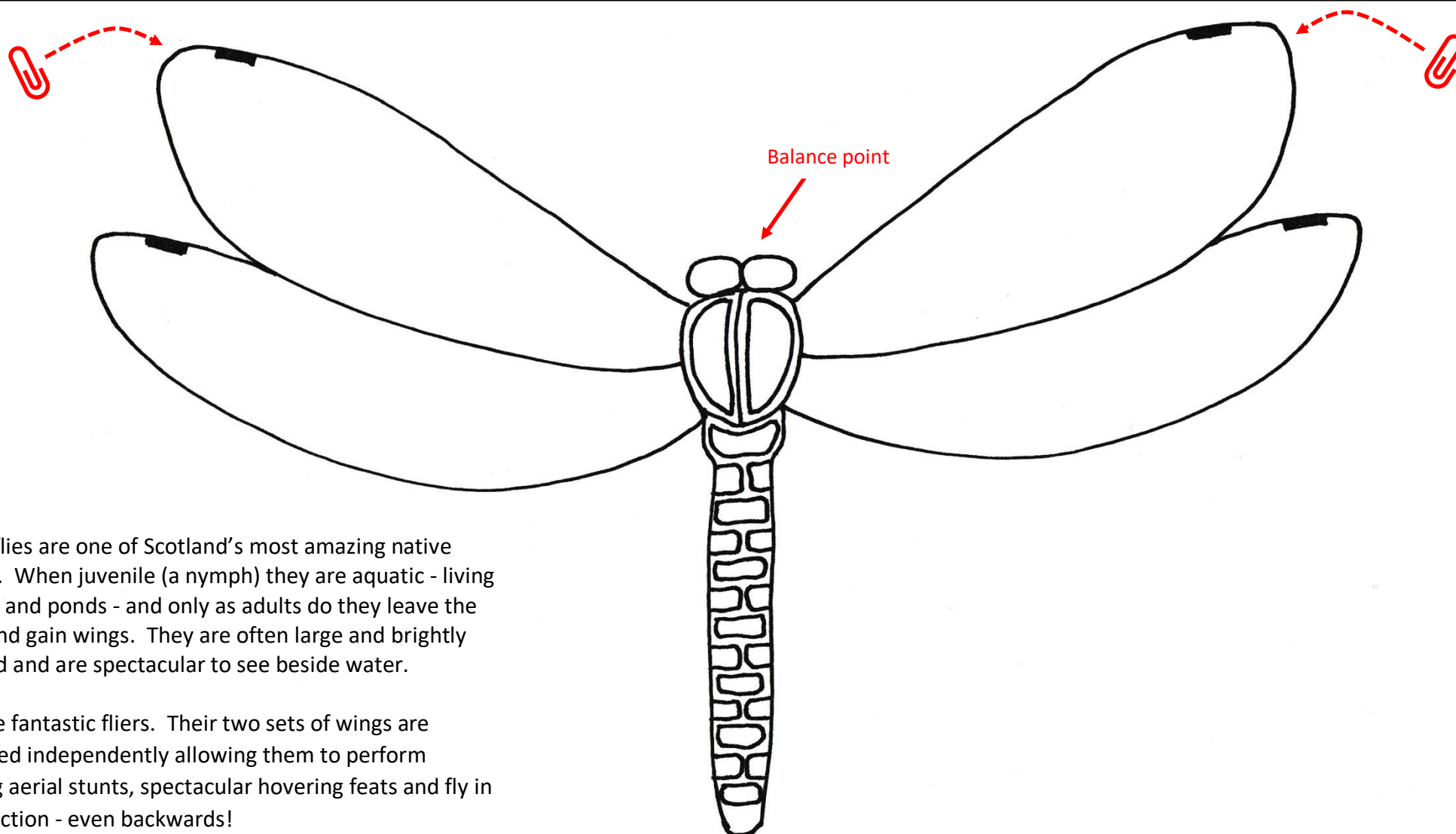


Print out our lovely dragonfly on thin card, colour in, cut out and put a paper clip on the tip of each wing – and watch it balance on your finger!



Dragonflies are one of Scotland's most amazing native animals. When juvenile (a nymph) they are aquatic - living in rivers and ponds - and only as adults do they leave the water and gain wings. They are often large and brightly coloured and are spectacular to see beside water.

They are fantastic fliers. Their two sets of wings are controlled independently allowing them to perform amazing aerial stunts, spectacular hovering feats and fly in any direction - even backwards!
