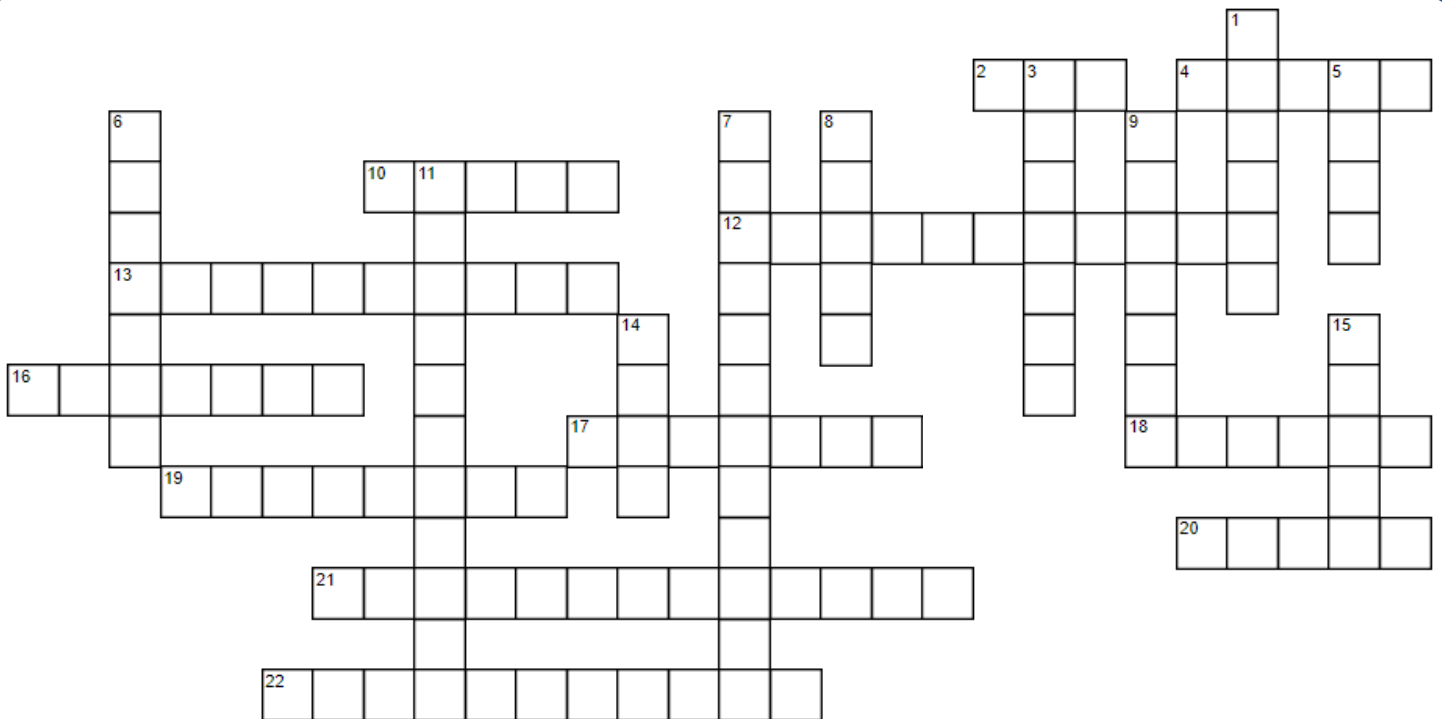




Crossword Puzzle
